Guidelines for Team Participation

UEC encourages team participation at any time after you have attended a UEC weekend. It is a good way to pass on the gift of grace you have been given and come to a better understanding of what happens "behind the scenes". It is also a very fun and rewarding experience. It may be wise to give yourself a little time to let your weekend "sink in" before serving on a team. To give everyone a chance to serve, we recommend serving no more than once per year and we encourage you to try all the teams as each team experience will give further insight into how to live a life of grace and extend that grace to others.

What is Unidos en Cristo (UEC)?

UEC is a structured three-day weekend designed to strengthen and renew the faith of Christian people bringing a new and more active awareness of living in God's grace. The weekend focus is on Christ and a personal relationship with Him. UEC begins on Thursday evening and ends on Sunday evening. There is an abundance of teaching, music, singing, fellowship, food, laughter, friendship and prayer throughout the weekend. *UEC is not sensitivity training, nor a treatment for personal problems or emotional difficulties.*
