What is Unidos en Cristo (UEC)?

UEC is a structured three-day weekend designed to strengthen and renew the faith of Christian people bringing a new and more active awareness of living in God's grace. The weekend focus is on Christ and a personal relationship with Him. UEC begins on Thursday evening and ends on Sunday evening. There is an abundance of teaching, music, singing, fellowship, food, laughter, friendship and prayer throughout the weekend. *UEC is not sensitivity training, nor a treatment for personal problems or emotional difficulties.*

Mission Statement of UEC

"To revive and strengthen Christian commitment and community in the local church."

Faith Statement of UEC

"Unidos en Cristo is an inter-denominational and lay led community whose purpose is to help persons deepen a personal living faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

The UEC community emphasizes the essentials of our Christian faith, which include the triune nature of God, the absolute authority of the Word of God, the forgiveness of sins through the blood of Jesus, and our common adoption into the body of Christ.

UEC equips Christian servants for action through a practical and personal demonstration of God's grace and by encouraging the extension of this grace to the local church and community.

We believe a living faith in Jesus Christ and Christian action will change our world."

How to attend an UEC Weekend

To attend a UEC weekend, you will need a Sponsor. Your Sponsor will help you to facilitate the processing of your application. Here are the steps. It is best to follow the steps in order:

1. Applicant completes Applicant portion of the application and gives to Sponsor.
2. Sponsor completes Sponsor portion of the application and gives to the Liaison or Pastor.
3. Pastor completes the Clergy portion of the application and gives to the Liaison.
4. UEC Liaison completes the Liaison portion of the application and sends the application to the UEC Allocations Coordinator for processing. A fee of \$40.00 per Applicant should accompany the application. Please date your check for first day of weekend.

Applicant Policies

- Applicant for a weekend will be a member or active participant in a UEC church or in a church that is active in a different cursillo-type movement.
- Applicant for a weekend will be at least 21 years old at the time of the weekend.
- For married couples, it is customary and strongly recommended that both husband and wife attend UEC together on the same set of weekends. We encourage you to read the brochure, "UEC and the Married Couple" for better understanding of WHY we recommend this. While UEC is not a marriage renewal weekend, testimonies by married couples that have attended UEC together indicate that common Christian purpose is often discovered when both spouses share a similar experience and understanding.
- Applicants who are being sponsored by those from another UEC church should be cosponsored by someone from the Applicant's church.
- Clergy Signature is required before an application is accepted. If church does not have a UEC clergy, then a non-UEC clergy or the UEC Liaison may sign the application.
