Convenor's Notebook

"NOW THAT I 'VE BEEN THROUGH CURSILLO, HOW DO I GET ON A TEAM?"

If you are like most of the United Cursillo Community and have not as yet participated on a Cursillo team, this is a question I am sure you have asked your sponsors or other Cursillistas. Believe me, there is not a week that goes by that someone doesn't ask me what the secret is about team participation.

I suppose the next best thing to going through Cursillo as a candidate is to be part of a team and be there to serve God by making the experience rewarding for someone else. As you serve, you also grow spiritually, and the team experience can be helpful to all of us by preparing and equipping us to do other forms of Christian evangelism and outreach in our own churches, communities and beyond!

So what's the secret to getting on a team? There really is no "secret", but there are some ways that you can make it known that you do wish to be part of a Cursillo team. Probably the easiest way is to go through a Cursillo weekend, and you have already done that! After your weekend, your name and other information go into our United Cursillo computer listing. Then, as each new rector and rectora are selected for future Cursillos, they are given copies of this computer list to aid them in team formation. Cursillo guidelines state that each team should be made up of 70% first-time members and 30% experienced team members, excluding the leadership positions.

Another way is for you to take the initiative yourself--call or write or volunteer! By watching the PALANCA PRESS you will see the dates and locations of future weekends and the names of the rectors and rectoras. You can also write in care of this address to the Cursillo office. Other good sources are your sponsors, church Cursillo liaison persons, or your church clergy.

The newest way to be part of a team is the sign-up form found in this issue of the PALANCA PRESS. If you would like to be on a team, just complete the short questionnaire and mail it to the address listed on the sheet.

There are a few guidelines that I would like to suggest that you follow, too. Since our Cursillo community is very large, and the number of places on a team few by comparison, it is suggested that all of us work on no more than one team a year. This, hopefully, will give more people the opportunity to participate. If you are one of the "old hands" at Cursillo, and have worked several teams, possibly you sould have even more time between team experiences.

Also, if you are a new Fourth Dayer, I feel that it is good to wait six months to one year before you work a team. In this way you will have time to become active in your renewal group, attend

some Ultreyas and Clausuras, and gain an appreciation for the meaning of Fourth Day (the post-Cursillo phase).

Finally, I would say that there truly is a joy in serving our friend, Jesus. A Currillo team is just one of the many ways. We only need to look around us and listen for His call to find other ways to glorify Him and pass on His love.
