Convenor's Corner

1989 has already been an exciting year. God has been good and I know that the Holy Spirit is alive and at work in United Cursillo. Because of His "nudging", the support and generosity of the United Cursillo Community has been overwhelming. As a result, we have been able to purchase our own weekend supplies ... mattresses and all. We have been so grateful to the Episcopal Cursillo Community for allowing us to use their supplies since 1981. Having our own supplies, however, will now give us more flexibility in scheduling future weekends.

We thought we had "arrived". Soon we realized we still had a problem. Where are we going to store these supplies and how will we transport them from weekend to weekend? God again provided a solution. One of the members on our council donated a 38 foot semi-trailer that he no longer needed for his business. This palanca solved both problems of storage and transportation. It also is a big benefit to the 4th Day teams who are often packing and loading supplies following the Sunday night closura long after you and I have gone home.

With that major hurdle out of the way, you would think we would be ready to add additional weekends to our schedule. But we still have one more obstacle, and it has been our number one problem for years. We constantly have a difficult time finding clergy to fill our weekends.

The reasons for this are too numerous to mention here and most are valid. Simple math tells us, however, that this shouldn't be a problem. Each set of weekends requires six Spiritual Directors. If we schedule three sets of weekends and one single women's weekend, that means we need 21 clergy for the year. Right now we have about 60 churches that make up the United Cursillo Community, many of which have multiple staff that are Cursillistas. At last count there are over 90 clergy that are still in their current positions and parish. This tells us that we shouldn't be having trouble filling Spiritual Director spots on weekends.

I do have some ideas on how we as lay people can help *enable* our ministers to participate on a Cursillo weekend. Many of you are in positions of leadership in your church and you can use your influence in a positive way to help pave the way for your minister to participate.

- 1. Don't badger your minister to serve, but rather encourage him. Remind them that yes they are serving, but they cannot escape a weekend without being blessed and renewed. Help them to understand the importance of their participation, not only to the United Cursillo movement, but to your community as well.
- 2. In order for many clergy to serve on a team, they must use their own vacation time to attend. This is clearly not a vacation ... it is really an extended ministry of the church. Help your minister to be able to schedule a weekend with the blessings of your church board. If you are a single-staffed church, find a lay person to *cover* for a Sunday. If you have trouble filling your pulpit, the council can help.
- 3. Is your home Cursillo community alive and active? Is your minister seeing the *fruits* of the Cursillo experience realized through your group? That type of joy and serving is contagious. Organize your group, hold regular monthly Ultreyas and include your clergy.
- 4. I have always said that the *power* of God through the Cursillo movement is a *force* to be reckoned with. Consider having your Cursillo group take on a project within your church. Could you start a neighborhood food shelf, or sponsor a needy or displaced family? Maybe a clothing drive or help to sponsor a missionary from your church. Whatever it is, let your parish know that your community is doing this in the name of Christ, and not Cursillo.

In closing, let us remember what the main purpose of Cursillo is. This "short course in Christianity helps us to sharpen our focus on personal and church renewal, thereby convicting us to work towards transforming all our environments into Christian environments. The Cursillo is a lay-led movement, but we clearly cannot be successful without the guidance and support of our clergy and the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Out-of-Staters: Can You Send Palanca?

What is your best memory of your Cursillo weekend? For many, it is the palanca, in all its forms. For some, it was fish crackers; for others, Rolo brand candy; and for others, a palanca note from someone in Chattanooga or Nome, Alaska.

Recent United Cursillos have been blessed with plentiful palanca, but one area that has been lacking has been "notes from afar". So, if you're reading this letter from California or Wisconsin or New York, please give some thought to sending a palanca note to upcoming weekends.
