This past June I had the privilege of serving on the Episcopal Cursillo #04 near Edinburgh, Scotland along with former council member Nancy Anderson. A team from Wales put on a Cursillo exactly one year ago and already they will be having their 5th Cursillo in August and 6th in November (Nancy Anderson will be Rectora). The teams and the number of participants is small yet (June had 16 team members and 14 weekenders), but they are very enthusiastic and growing. The Bishop of the Edinburgh Diocese and the priests from several parishes are in full support of Cursillo. Many of the details of the weekend are different from ours (e.g. their weekends are always co-ed with husbands and wives at separate tables), but the Cursillo experience and the working of the Holy Spirit are wonderfully the same. I will close with the familiar saying that the Bishop used in his comments at the Closura.
