Thank You Note from the Outgoing T.E.C. Convener

(From Robin Berg - September 1990)

The first three years of United T.E.C. are almost completed and since this is our first change of conveners, it is a good time to review our status and also say thanks to some very special people.

The United T.E.C. council was called together at the end of 1987 by the United Cursillo council. Since that start, we have organized and had eight weekends and about 400 teen candidates from a very broad range of churches. There is a strong base of teens to work the weekends and they accept the responsibility to do the work and make things happen safely and in a timely order. The movement is on solid financial ground. We have four weekends and reunions per year and are expanding with a new council in southeastern Minnesota and neighboring Iowa through Mark Opseth's efforts. Bob Fields is looking to find interested people and lead a movement for college age candidates. We have discussed sending teams to starter groups in West Virginia and Boston. I highly endorse all of these efforts.

There are a few people that have developed a special meaning to me and I would like to share some of those experiences with you. There are four youth that were instrumental in founding United T.E.C., and I call them the first Metanoia kids because they caused a T.E.C. turning point. I was greatly impressed in 1979 by Ara Burwell, who set an excellent example of a young Christian. Her parents gave much credit to her attending an Episcopal T.E.C. Second is my son, Tim, who attended an Eau Claire Episcopal T.E.C. in 1981. Our improved communication was something that I wanted all Cursillo parents to have the opportunity to experience. Tim became a Metanoia kid when he drove through a snow storm to a Cursillo council in 1986 and convinced the board to give a high priority to T.E.C. with his wittiness and answering of questions. God has blessed Tim as he has since graduated from the U and M.I.T. and is presently doing his Ph.D. work at Oxford. The third Metanoia kid is Bronwyn Shepard for her contributions to the original council meeting as our first high school member. The fourth Metanoia kid is Ingrid Aasan for being our first Rectora, returning to be an adult table leader and joining in at closings.

There are some adults that have worked hard and I will mention some of the small things that have stuck in my memory. We received a lot of cooperation and openness from both the Episcopal and Lutheran T.E.C.'s and convener Diane Henning of the Lutheran T.E.C. contributed greatly to our first weekend. The abundance of early organizational work got a jump start by Pastor Gary Downing, Kit Schmoker and Mark Opseth in reviewing literature from other T.E.C.'s and suggesting T.E.C. philosophy, weekend agendas, guidelines and setting the job descriptions for T.E.C. Bob Fields always was there making wise purchases, keeping inventory, finding swimming pools, building crosses for the Stations of the Cross and growing the wheat for the table centerpieces. Lee and Mary Edlund started the T.E.C. Times, but their wisdom at the council meeting was an even bigger contribution. Beth Cone was a positive, supportive secretary before she organized our accounting procedures as well as informed us about Cursillo interests. Nancy Gin, Jim Broecker and my wife, Mickey, are from my Hudson church. Nancy had a big job organizing allocations, writing letters to the parents, making application forms and, of course, executing the program for the first two years. Peggy Zender joined us with her optimistic and efficient nature to finalize and type many drafts. Peggy created, published and maintains our blue books. Co-convener Terri Gulliford used her enthusiastic personality to take special interest in each weekend and carried forward when I was traveling. Terri made my job much easier.

Thanks to all of the above for much more than I mentioned and thanks to many others that should be mentioned and to a great many that sent wheat, prayers and/or your children. The T.E.C. board especially thanks the clergy and youth for taking the cause and making our efforts all worthwhile. We thank the Lord for choosing us to help in His work. Those of us that are leaving, wish the very best blessings and God's speed for all that carry this worthy movement forward.
