#### **Convenor's Comments**

Some issues give rise to strong feelings and different points of view, even in Cursillo. The scheduling of a singles weekend for June 18-21, 1992 is one of those topics. Our United Cursillo Council recently voted to continue its wholehearted support of periodic singles weekends, but only after lengthy discussion of the pros and cons of the idea.

All of the weekenders on a singles Cursillo are unmarried, but the team usually includes both single and married people. Singles weekends have been conducted successfully in recent years in both the United Cursillo community and in other Cursillo movements.

Supporters of the idea suggest that many single people feel uncomfortable on a conventional Cursillo weekend where much of the discussion among married participants may focus on spouses and children. Many singles have indicated that they will participate more freely in a group of other unmarried people. Others in the Cursillo community have questioned whether weekends should be devoted exclusively to the singles family, that the basic short course in Christianity should be the same for everyone and that all weekends are enriched by a diversity of marital status.

So who is right? After reviewing both sides of the issue, the Council decided that perhaps this is not a right/wrong issue. Some single people clearly enjoy the opportunity to be with unmarried peers and sometimes feel excluded in groups where issues relating to marriage and parenting often dominate.

Other single people don't want to be categorized as a part of a special group and prefer the mix of single and married people found on most conventional weekends. The person's preference may depend, at least in part, upon whether he or she is widowed, divorced or never-married.

In fact, the original idea for singles weekends didn't arise out of any ideological position on the part of the Council but rather out of a desire to reduce the backlog of single people, primarily women, on the waiting lists for weekends. Recently, that problem has been addressed by adding a seventh table in the Rollo Room on several women's weekends, allowing the addition of six single weekenders. (The singles are not all located at the extra table, but instead are spread throughout the room). The result is that singles have reasonable access to both types of weekends.

As potential sponsors, we ask each of you to prayerfully consider which of your single friends may benefit from the special feeling of a singles weekend. If you identify possible weekenders for our June singles Cursillo, please notify Kathy Anderson at 920-1261

We will still follow our normal allocations process for the weekend, but we would like to have a preliminary indication of the level of participation we can expect.

Mark your calendars for the Closura on June 21, 1992. We'll let you know the location in a few weeks. Join the rest of the Fourth Day Community in welcoming the weekenders at the end of their special Cursillo experience.

The issue of commercialism occasionally surfaces in Cursillo in a variety of ways, including notes in palanca bags from suppliers of Cursillo material or other commercial ventures, letters addressed to people on the team or weekender lists or the general Cursillo roster offering products or services, and messages promoting Cursillo music during Closuras or Ultreyas.

All such activities are clearly against United Cursillo Council policy and run contrary to the spirit and purpose of Cursillo.

By the end of a weekend, the palanca bags for team members and weekenders are filled with notes and gifts expressing the love and support of the Fourth Day Community. The messages represent the work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of those who receive and those who give. Commercial messages of any kind have no place in this process.

Similarly, the team and weekender lists, as well as the roster of the Cursillo community, are published by United Cursillo to further the Cursillo movement and its activities. The use of the lists by anyone for purposes other than the furtherance of Cursillo activities and business, particularly commercial enterprise, is improper and prohibited.

So far, these comments have sounded too much like the mundane issues we all face in our daily lives. Perhaps we need a *mountain top* experience to help us focus on our lives in Grace. May I suggest attending the Closuras at St. Croix Valley United Methodist on the last Sunday of January and the first Sunday of February? You will be glad you did.
