### **Cursillo Around the World!**

Leigh Jewell, a short term missionary from Afton, MN, and member of the Lutheran Community, and I, have had a dream of extending Cursillo to the members of the United Church of Japan in the area around Osaka where we live. It has been a bumpy road, but we feel great hope in God's leading and guiding.

Last February, a Japanese pastor, another missionary and I went to a Cursillo near Tokyo sponsored by the Franciscan Chapel in Toyko, an English language Roman Catholic Church. There were participants from the US, Australia, The Philippines, Mexico and Great Britain. The English speaking leaders worried about teaching Spanish words to all the Spanish speaking people there! It was a very simple Cursillo and we didn't even have a chicken, but the priest knew a great number of "groaner" jokes which provided the needed comic relief. The talks were powerful, and it was a time when we were taught, nurtured, healed and led by God's Spirit of Grace.

The three of us are now meeting with a couple more people to plan a Cursillo in Japanese. We want to involve the leadership of the church so we are proceeding slowly with study, translation and prayer.

Thank you for your support both financially and in prayer. Being part of a world-wide community is a tremendous help as we prepare here in the Osaka/Kobe area. I'll write again as plans get in place.
