Men's Cursillo #89 will take place at COLONIAL CHURCH OF EDINA Sept 17-20. The Sunday morning serenade (5:30 a.m.) and the evening serenade (5:30 p.m.) are open to the 4th Day Cursillo Community. The weekend theme is "... guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life", (Proverbs 4:23).

Women's Cursillo #90 will be held at CHRIST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH Sept 24-27. The weekend theme is based on Colossians 3:12-17, and the key verse is "Set your hearts on things above", (Colossians 3:1). The Sunday 5:30 a.m. serenade is for sponsors only (only female sponsors will be allowed in the sleeping rooms), while the Sunday evening serenade is for the entire Fourth Day Community at 5:30 p.m. SPECIAL PALANCA NOTE: THERE WILL BE AN EXTRA TABLE at the women's weekend, resulting in 6 more weekenders and 2 more silent table leaders. Therefore, the Rollo Room will have 56 women at tables, plus 7 persons in leadership.

Please take careful note of the weekend locations. This is the first time that the men's and women's weekends will be held at different churches.

Convener's Comments

As I begin my term serving as your Convener, I must comment on a couple things that have caught my attention over the time that I have been involved in Cursillo. The first is the faithfulness of so many of you to keep Cursillo going. Every weekend takes literally hundreds of hours of people's time collectively to prepare. This is time which is required during the team meetings as well as the time required outside of the team meetings. What is not seen, but is always felt is the prayers of the fourth day community. My sense is that there is more collective time given to a weekend by the fourth day community in their prayer time than is given by the team members in handon activities. Prayer is the single most important element in the success of any individual weekend and in the overall goals of Cursillo.

The second thing that I want to comment on is the leadership in Cursillo. I cannot say enough good about the leadership that I have seen and experienced as I have served on various teams. It becomes obvious very quickly when a leader seeks his/her leadership from God. Because Cursillo leadership is Christ-centered, we are truly one team, with a common desire to serve our Lord.

Within the leadership of Cursillo, I want to single out the clergy for a minute. Clergy is the backbone of the weekend. They provide the spiritual guidance to the weekend while the lay members take care of many of the administrative details. Clergy is also a vital part of Cursillo back at the home churches in supporting and encouraging Cursillistas and would-be Cursillistas. If there is an area that we have not adequately addressed, in my mind it is the recognition of the contribution our clergy have made to Cursillo. Many of our clergy have served over and over and made it possible for so many of us to experience God's love in the way that can only be described in the Cursillo way.

The final thing that I want to comment on is my own leadership. United Cursillo is governed by the United Cursillo Council which in turn is led by a Convener. Because I believe in the leadership style exemplified by Jesus when He washed the feet of the disciples, I view my position as one of service first to God, and second to each of you in the fourth day community. I say this to let you know that I want to hear any suggestions you have that will help us to be more effective and more efficient in spreading God's love through Cursillo. As it says on the back of the cross that we received on our weekend - "Christ is counting on you".
