Dear Cursillistas,

#### Council Positions

Cursillo is known to lack some of the organizational bureaucracy that plagues other groups or organizations. It is not highly structured and has no paid staff. However, there are still many things that need to be accomplished in order to make the weekends happen. Sometimes I think the appearance that cursillo is not highly organized happens only because the organizational skills of many people doing their jobs well give the illusion that the weekends "just happen".

Cursillo is governed by the United Cursillo Council which is comprised of fifteen lay members and three clergy. This is the group who work to continue this unique, ecumenical Cursillo movement in Minnesota.

There is much to be done before a weekend can be held. The process of selecting and training leadership and clergy for weekends, choosing church sites, maintaining supplies, coordinating palanca, supporting renewal activities, managing finances, publishing the Palanca Press, and more, fills much of the spare time of most members of the Council. However, the Council members will tell you that they receive much more from their service than they give. (Kind of like serving on a team.)

At this time of the year, we begin the process of inviting 5 new lay members and 1 new clergy member to become part of the Council to replace the members who are completing their three year terms. (This year we have two clergy positions to fill.)

Please take time to prayerfully consider submitting the nomination of Cursillistas who you believe should be considered for Council positions. They should be active in Cursillo and in their home church, and should show evidence of a life of faith in Jesus Christ. Diversity of age, gender, geography, and church affiliation is important to the Council. You are encouraged to nominate yourself if you feel called to serve Christ in this way. Please complete the form on the reverse side and return it to the address shown.

#### JOG Contribution

Again this year we are requesting that you prayerfully consider contributing a JOG (Joy of Giving) donation. The United Cursillo has been very effective in providing Christian ministry while keeping the costs to a minimum. We rely on the thousands of hours

donated each year by team members, but we also need the annual financial donation.

Currently, United Cursillo spend over \$23,000 per year. Our needs are modest, but they are real. The direct expenses of each weekend, such as the cost of food and supplies, are usually covered by JOG from team members and weekenders and from collections at Closuras. Additional funds are needed, however, to cover ongoing expenses such as the Palanca Press, the Fourth Day roster, the supplies and supply trailer, team manuals, and insurance.

We depend on the several thousand dollars raised each year in response to this annual JOG appeal to keep Cursillo going. Please consider making a contribution at this time.

#### **Convener's Comments**

With this issue of the Palanca Press, I want to take an opportunity to encourage Fourth Day support for 2 significant events which will take place during 1993. You will find information in this newsletter announcing a music workshop in June, which will be led by Yohann Anderson. This is a tremendous opportunity for people who have led music or are considering leading music on a Cursillo weekend, in a renewal group, in Sunday School, or just about any other place you can think of to lead music. The afternoon workshop will be followed by an all-United Ultreya (not just for attendees of the workshop). Please set aside that date for this once-in-a-lifetime experience!

The second event was announced in the last issue of the Palanca Press, but bears repeating. The November weekends have been designated "Southern Minnesota" weekends, and will be staffed by Cursillistas from south of the Metro area to the maximum extent possible. This set of weekends may be a turning point for communities located too far away to participate easily in weekends located in the Twin City area. Please support these weekends with your prayers, your palanca, and your presence at the closuras.

On another note, some things have occured on recent weekends that need to be addressed. The first thing I need to ask is for the Cursillo Community to respect the host churches. Please remember at all times that we are guests in these churches, and are grateful for the opportunity to use their facilities. Let them know you appreciate their hospitality by doing what you can to leave the church in a better condition than we found it, and by respecting other activities that may be going on at the same time. We need to be particularly conscious of not disturbing the Sunday worship services in the host churches.

Secondly, there has been an increasing number of children at recent closuras. Parents have, in the past, been encouraged to make other arrangements whenever possible. With the continuing addition of new cursillistas, this bears repeating. Many of the closuras tend to be standing room only, so for logistics reasons alone, it is preferable to limit attendance to cursillistas.

To close on a more positive note, please prayerfully consider your response to the enclosed JOG letter. The Cursillo Counçil is comprised of 15 lay members and 3 clergy, each serving a 3 year term. One third of the Council terms expire each year. Now is your chance to participate in the leadership by nominating the next group of leaders. Please take this responsibility seriously and submit your nominations on the enclosed form. Remember, "Christ is counting on you!" and so is the Council.


