Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

My wife and I recently learned about a young man who had been seriously injured when he was hit by an automobile while leaving his parents' home. He was in a coma, and the next 24 hours were critical. He is not from our community but we learned about him from a fellow Cursillista. We began praying for him and his family. That evening I attended a meeting at a neighboring church with other Cursillistas. They already knew about this young man and had been praying... I thought about our Christian community — In action. We do not know if this family knows Jesus Christ, and we don't know the young man. But that doesn't matter. God knows, and God is working in that hospital room. God will surround those parents with His heavenly angels. He will strengthen them, whether they are aware of Him or not. Such is the power of prayer. Such is the Christian community when it turns its face toward God. We do not know how God will move in this situation. We only know that He will hear our prayers of intercession, and He will answer.

Prayer is one of our great opportunities, responsibilities, and privileges as Christians!
