# "Come Back to Me"

#### (An open letter to all Fourth Dayers):

One of the more popular songs in our Cursillo music repertoire is *Hosea* with its haunting line, "Come back to me with your heart; don't let fear keep us apart." Whenever it is stated that there are more than 5000 Cursillistas in the Twin Cities Cursillo Movement, one cannot help but wonder why it is sometimes difficult to staff teams. So difficult, in fact, that the same people wind up working at least one weekend per year, year after year. In a sense, this line from *Hosea* could apply to those legions of Fourth Dayers who were once equally active in the earlier days of the Twin Cities Cursillo Movement but are seldom seen working weekends anymore.

We don't know what it is that keeps them from working weekends. What we do know is that without their faith-filled labors of love and service to the Lord, there would be no Cursillo Movement in the Twin Cities today. We also know the Holy Spirit who called them to work on teams years ago is the same Holy Spirit that is calling them today to come "into the fields" for still today the "harvest is plenty, the laborers few."

One is led to an awareness of the fact that one of the great blessings of the Cursillo Movement is the diversity of its Cursillistas, which is essential to its ability to penetrate and evangelize all environments. Weekenders still come to their weekends not just from diverse backgrounds, but of varying ages as well. They need to hear the faith-filled stories of people of varied ages who have labored in love for Cursillo. They need to learn that the work of rebuilding the Kingdom of God on earth is a lifelong, ongoing endeavor. They need to experience the personal witness of long-term Cursillistas whose loving commitment to the movement has imbued them with an inner light and spiritual strength that can only come from living the Method!

And so, long-absent Fourth Dayers, we now issue a heart-felt personal invitation to you. We dearly need the unique spiritual richness and giftedness that only you can bring to Cursillo. We still have Weekenders who hunger to hear of your labors and successes; who long for the spiritual mentoring and modeling that only you can bring; and who need to see people who have aged gracefully in working for the Lord. After all, life experiences have always spoken louder than words in Cursillo!

Please open yourself to the Lord for yet another call to serve Him in His Cursillo Movement. Send in a team application, and let the Holy Spirit once again issue His personal call to you.
