That seems like a good description of the world in which I live, how about you? Kids back in school, the changing color of the leaves, the crisp air, shorter days of sunlight, church fall programs beginning, new ("Unidos En Cristo") name, new council members and responsibilities. Change for me does not always come easily. In some ways I seem to have a false sense of security when there is no change in my life. At other times, realizing growth comes with change. The year will be a transition for all of us. The passage from Hebrews 13:8 states, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever." What wonderful security and strength we have through Jesus Christ. May all of us keep focused on Him as we serve Him through our churches and Unidos En Cristo.

At our first council meeting this fall, we had a commissioning and consecration service with the anointing of oil and the sacrament of Holy Communion lead by Clergy council members. The prayer we prayed was, "Almighty God, pour out your blessings upon us your servants. Grant us your grace to give ourselves wholeheartedly in your service. Keep before us the example of our Lord Jesus Christ, who did not think first of himself but of others and who gave himself for us all. Let us share in his ministry and enter into his joy. Guide us in our work. Reward our faithfulness with the knowledge that, through us, your purposes are accomplished; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen" We also committed ourselves to praying for a specific council member in the coming year.

Unidos En Cristo

At the request of the Office of the National Secretariat of the Cursillo movement, and to honor their copyright of the name Cursillo, a task force was formed a year ago to implement a name change for the United Cursillo of Minnesota. As co-convenor, I was asked to chair the task force with members Doug Dahl, Kathy Dyrdal, Martin Johnson, Cherie Middleton, Betty Selness and Bob Zalk. In the beginning it appeared to be a huge challenge and responsibility, but with a lot of prayer support and God's direction we started the process. Copyright searches, discussions, suggestions from the Fourth Day Community, legal counsel, and listening were all part of the process.

As months passed, there was no doubt the Fourth Day Community wanted to retain the Spanish flavor of the United weekends. Many of you expressed the need to keep the united, non-denominational spirit of the movement before us. God's grace, joy, love and peace were all words that came to mind when speaking of the weekends. In June, we came together to finalize the recommendation to the council. Carmen Pickney was invited to that meeting. Carmen is an active member in the United Community and fluent in the Spanish language. She was very helpful in the process of selecting a Spanish name that captured the flavor and spirit of a United Weekend. The weekends are Christ-centered, with God's grace, joy, love and peace being very evident. How about United in Christ? "Unidos En Cristo"? We all made calls and asked for reactions. Some were negative, but most were overwhelmingly positive. On June 24, 1997, the council approved the recommendation from the task force that our name become "Unidos En Cristo" (oo-knee-dose en cree-stow). We know it may not "roll off your tongue" to begin with ... but then again, did Cursillo?)

We thank our Catholic brothers and sisters for the gift of Cursillo given to us, and for allowing us to continue to use the "technique" of their movement.

We have felt your prayers and would like to say thank you! The process will continue with legal counsel, paperwork and changes yet to be determined. Paul Schwamb, as co-convenor, will chair the task force as it continues the process. We covet your prayers as we continue as "Unidos En Cristo"!
