

Others in the Fourth Day Community may have no other way of knowing special friends in Christ have now entered His glorious presence.

### Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

"What were you doing reading 10 years of council minutes?" Many of you were responding to my comments in the last Palanca Press. I'm glad you asked!! TEC (Teens Encounter Christ) has been a vital ministry for the past 10+ years. We thank God the way He has changed and touched the lives of our teens through this ministry. Through the years TEC has had some challenges with their 'legal' identity, i.e. obtaining accounts, postal permits, etc. There have been no articles of incorporation or by-laws naming them as a recognized organization. Through the years, United Cursillo and now Unidos En Cristo has supported the ministry financially and through other means. In recent years there has been a TEC liaison attending the Cursillo/Unidos council meeting each month. Twice there were task forces formed to 'solidify' the relationship between Cursillo and TEC; however, I was unable to locate any 'action' items in the Cursillo minutes. For approximately 3 years, there was no mention of TEC in the Cursillo minutes. In recent years the TEC Council under the leadership of Rex Cooper and now Darrell Spoors has made great strides in the areas of accountability and organization. This is not to say that the previous leadership did not make progress but the more recent council felt it was time to make a very direct and strong affiliation with the Cursillo/Unidos council. At the November 25, 1997 Unidos En Cristo council meeting, Martin Johnson, Dave Tellett and I were directed to become a task force and charged to "Decide how we (Unidos) can best accommodate incorporating TEC into this body." After reading the past 10 years of Cursillo/Unidos minutes, a number of meetings, phone calls, conversations and wonderful prayer support, we came back to the Unidos Council on January 27, 1998 with the following recommendations:

- 1) TEC to become a part of Unidos En Cristo as a Committee, and written into the by-laws, as such
- Create a new position on the Unidos Council; a TEC spokesperson that will be a liaison that will attend both Unidos and TEC meetings and will also be a voting member on the Unidos Council.
- 3) Both, Unidos and TEC Council Treasurers will be bonded
- 4) Unidos will receive monthly financial statements from the TEC treasurer. (TEC's yearly financial statement will be combined with Unidos and annually reported to the IRS.)
- 5) Continue to be a line of accountability and support to one another.

The Unidos En Cristo moved, seconded and approved to adopt these recommendations.

I, would also like to remind you that nominations are still open for the Unidos Council. There are seven positions to fill, including I clergy position and I 'new' TEC position. The term is for 3 years, beginning in September of 1998. Please send your nominations, along with biographical information, to Nominations Committee, 15144 Everleigh Circle, Rosemount, MN 55068.

Criteria for a Unidos council member includes:

- A Living faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and His Word
- Has attended a Cursillo/Unidos En Cristo weekend
- Has served on a Cursillo/Unidos En Cristo team as a part of leadership
- Is an active member of the 4th day community (weekends, renewal group, Ultreyas)
- Is a member in good standing in a Unidos En Cristo church
- Is an active participant in the life of his or her home church
- Can commit to monthly meetings September through June, plus the duties of the position
