### DeColores and Happy New Year!

How are you doing at writing 2000 on your checks (or any other place a date is required)? I must admit that 19 certainly has cropped up a time or two from my pen before I have realized that I'm a bit behind the times. It's going to take some concentration and practice for me to get used to writing that new date correctly. After all, I've been starting out with 19– for a long time! Boy, it's a good thing that people are understanding. I appreciate their patience, that's for sure. Perhaps they are having the same difficulties. How hard it is to break old habits and get so used to something new that it becomes second nature. I've been told that it takes two to three weeks of repetition before an activity becomes a habit. We'll see how I'm doing in March.

This makes me think of the effort it took to get into a routine for consistently studying the Bible and setting aside time each day for prayer and other devotional reading. It was not an easy habit for me to adopt. I tried setting aside time at night when everything was quiet in the house but found my eyelids just wouldn't stay up. I tried a middle of the day slot but found that my days are not routine enough that there could ever be a consistency to my efforts. For me, the solution is studying first thing in the morning. It's taken concentration and practice to get into that routine. (Some days a little extra sleep sounds very tempting!) But what once was not a normal mode of operation for me has now become routine through patience, practice and an understanding of priorities. Think back to the rollo on STUDY. Have you been incorporating some of those suggestions into your daily or weekly activities? How about celebrating your life in Christ this year by making a commitment to be consistent in your prayer and study times? You'll find the benefits are 'out of this world'! Have a great 2000!
