With the warm weather arriving, I have been drawn to the outdoors: sprucing up the yard, mowing the lawn, planting flowers, mowing the lawn, trimming trees, mowing the lawn, washing windows, mowing the lawn ... you get the idea. This time of year has also brought our college student (and her mountain of stuff) home for the summer. We are in the process of finding places to put all her belongings which surely must have multiplied threefold since she left home. That means cleaning out the basement! There is certainly plenty of activity around here but as I write this I'm wondering, can I turn that activity into ACTION somehow? Let's see ...

The flowers we grow can be used to make 'get well' or 'I'm thinking about you' bouquets to be delivered to someone who needs a lift. The treasures that we clear out of the basement can be donated to a charitable organization or shelter. The yard work and window washing? What a great opportunity to get to know some on my unchurched neighbors better! But the lawn mowing time? Aside from making our home a more welcoming place for family and visitors I tend to use that as my own little praise and worship time. I could, of course, mow my neighbor's lawn while I'm at it but I usually settle into the seat of the riding mower and sing my way through a couple of hours of praise choruses or worship songs. (My version of singing in the shower, I guess.) It's also a great chance for me to talk with God. I'm sure He can hear over the din of the lawnmower. These are little ways anyone can make their activity change into action. What have you noticed going on around you?

One of my neighbors has become very involved in building houses with Habitat For Humanity as well as mentoring a Cambodian family. A friend delivers Meals On Wheels. Another volunteers at Mary's Place - a shelter for families. Others spend time sharing Christ's love with prison inmates or hospital patients. The youth from our church are busy preparing for mission trips. When a family from our church lost their house to a fire, people came out of the woodwork to help clean up and get them back on their feet. The list goes on and on. Why do these people give freely of their precious time and resources? For the most part, it is because they have come to know the love of God in their lives. Jesus gave us the commandment to "Love one another." and these actions are simply responses to the love He showed for us.

Remember the three (3) legged stool? ACTION is that third element that combines with PIETY and STUDY. It can be big or small but it must be filled with love. We may not see the fruits of our actions but that should not matter. God can use them for His purposes. We need only be obedient and do whatever we can to share His love. I agree completely with C.S. Lewis's sentiment that we should share the love of God and, if necessary, use words.

• Unidos en Cristo is twenty years old! The United Cursillo Community of Minnesota was incorporated on March 5, 1980 and held its first weekend in May of 1981. We hope to celebrate this milestone with an all-Unidos en Cristo Ultreya later this year.

- The mailing list for Unidos en Cristo is never sold to other organizations. The use of team or weekender lists for mailings for the purpose of solicitation or advertisement by individuals or other organizations is strictly prohibited. "The Unidos en Cristo mailing list will not be made available for use by outside churches or activities." (9/28/93)
- Applications for team participation are in each Palanca Press. Please fill in a new one each time you
 wish to be considered for team selection. Ideally, teams are formed 4-6 months in advance.
- Participation in the closing serenades and services is open to all musicians who are cursillistas. A lead musician is arranged by the Fourth Day Team but all are welcome to play. The Palanca Team has the option of choosing music for use during the communion service. If you are a musician who has never served as such on a team, let us know what you play and how you are willing to serve. Call Colleen at (612) 546-3923 to be added to our musician list.
- TEC members are welcome at any and all Unidos en Cristo functions, but may not be on a team until they are 21 years of age. (1/27/87)
- In the past year a few weekends have actually run at less than capacity. There is a general misconception that we always have a 'waiting list' and this clearly is not the case. If your church has several applications waiting to be sent to us please get them turned in to our Allocations coordinator during the appropriate application period. It is sad to hear someone say "We had to wait for 3 years to attend." when we have had space available. We cannot process applications that we never see.
- We are purchasing new trailers to store and transport our supplies. Cash donations may be made through our Treasurer, Roger Roth. 
