CONVENER'S CORNER

Allocations is the UEC ministry that fills Cursillo weekends with applicants. Over the last 20+ years, we have developed policies to do this in an orderly, fair and positive manner. Here's a brief review of these key weekender allocation policies:

1) Why is it important to get weekender applications in during the "applications window"?

Because it's your weekender's best chance to be accepted for a specific weekend. However, after the applications window closes, we continue to accept applicants as space permits – even up to the weekend itself.

2) Why do we only accept applications from active participants/members of UEC churches?

*A. Because we require the local pastor to sign applications so that he or she, as the spiritual leader of the congregation, is aware of the application(s) and can help the weekender(s) return and get spiritually engaged in a renewal group. Applicants should be committed Christians, **active in the church that is sponsoring them.** UEC operates only with the approval and participation of the local clergy.*

B. Because these weekends are about personal spiritual renewal, not a conversion opportunity for non-believers. Our goal is to build up our local churches and encourage ongoing spiritual renewal. To keep this spiritual renewal growing, it is crucial that weekenders have an understanding and supportive Christian community to return to – one that can help them get started in their own renewal group.

3) Why do we require husbands and wives to attend paired or succeeding weekends?

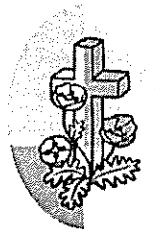
Because our experience, and the experience of other Cursillo-related movements, has been that allowing a married person to attend without their spouse can be detrimental to their marriage relationship. We are not willing to take that chance. If a spouse refuses to go, then it's probably not the right time for the couple to attend.

4) Do we allow exceptions to these policies?

In rare cases, we allow exceptions, e.g. when a spouse is physically or mentally unable to attend.

As we move forward, please be understanding and respectful of these carefully-considered policies; they are designed to protect the weekenders' experience, enhance ongoing renewal among active Christians and build up participating churches. Through our continued service together, may we all rejoice in the unfailing love and grace of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
