CLAUSURA ETIQUETTE

Clausura attendance is limited to persons (21 years and older) who have attended a Cursillo (UEC, VDC, Walk to Emmaus, etc.) weekend. Teens Encounter Christ (TEC) participants may also attend. It is inappropriate to bring children and infants because of the long worship service, and because seeing children at the Clausura can be painful for weekenders who are missing their own children.

Recorders, cameras and video cameras are not allowed at Clausuras. Cell phones and pagers should be turned off or set on "vibrate".

Please remember that we are guests of the host church, and that we are entrusted with the care of a large part of their facility. Always treat their "home" with care.

Dear Friends,

Occasionally we hear people fretting about “The weekends aren’t full!” or “We need more weekenders!” I used to briefly worry that we were somehow missing the boat, that we weren’t working hard enough or stressing the right things. This is such a great program - people should be clamoring to get in! Well, I was buying into the worldly view of “performance” and numbers - that we weren’t really successful unless the weekends were full (after all, we had waiting lists 5-10 years ago!) Well, times have changed. Unidos en Cristo rarely has waiting lists anymore. Our “busy-ness”, work commitments, lives that are scheduled six months in advance, plus many worthwhile and competing family, leisure and service opportunities make it difficult to schedule a weekend away – no matter how great it would be. Lack of a waiting list makes it a great opportunity for YOU to sponsor a weekender!

If you’ve been on teams, you know that – in spite of all our efforts and expectations – God will (and does!) reign on every weekend. Yes, we should be diligent in asking people to attend a weekend, make plans and work hard, but the “numbers” just aren’t that important. While each weekend is totally unique and some things “happen” differently than what we may have planned or come to expect, God will do it His way – not ours. So when someone frets about “not enough weekenders”, just smile and remind them gently that *God will do it His way!*

Because we historically have had more applications from women than from men, single weekender applicants have sometimes been bypassed in order to “equalize” the number of men and women attending paired weekends – even though the applicants had followed all the rules and met the application deadline! Our revised policy generally allows for acceptance of complete applications received within the allocations window. And, because of the typically larger number of women’s applications, we try to have an extra women’s table available if space permits. We would prefer to have roughly equal numbers of men and women attending each weekend, but that rarely happens. Please be aware: some men’s weekends may have as few as 20 men attending while the paired women’s weekend could have up to 42 women attending. And folks, that’s OK - because *God will do it His way!*

TEAM LEADERSHIP EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

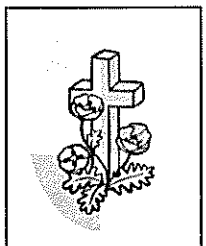
Following are the team leadership experience requirements, as recently updated and approved by the UEC Council.

- Individuals considered for service as Rollo Room Assistant should have previously served in the following UEC roles:
 - Rollista or table leader
 - Member of a support team
 - Rector/a or assistant of a support teamIdeally, a Rollo Room Assistant should only serve once in that position, allowing others the same privilege and training.
- With rare exceptions, individuals considered for Weekend Rector/a should have served in the following UEC leadership roles:
 - Rollista and/or table leader
 - Palanca Team – rector/a or assistant
 - Kitchen and/or 4th Day Team – preferably rector/a or assistant
 - Rollo Room Assistant

I’m looking forward to seeing many of you at the next set of Clausuras. Please come and support the weekenders and teams – and keep them in your daily prayers.

Your help is needed in soliciting nominations for the 2005-2006 Unidos en Cristo Council. Serving on the Council is another way to see God's wonderful grace working in and through this lay-led renewal movement. The criteria for a prospective candidate includes:

- Has attended a UEC weekend
- Has UEC team experience as part of leadership

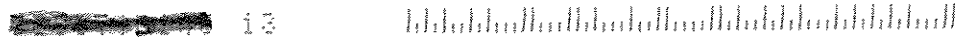
