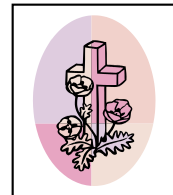
Thoughts expressed by these weekenders included:

The Third Leg of the Stool

De Colores, Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Do you remember the analogy to the three-legged stool from your weekend? Can you name the legs? Piety is the first leg and Study is the second. Piety is the basic step of being an apostle, a Christian. Study is hearing from God through His word.

The third leg is Action. There are 2 action rollos. Apostolic Action [#8] instructs how people are brought to Christ, and Christian Community in Action [#13] talks about the great impact we can have when we work as a Christian community. Combining these actions is very effective.

But the question is, "*are we just sitting on the stool?*"

If you are like me, your "apostolic actions" are inconsistent. There are times when we are fired up to bring others to Jesus, and times when busyness and fear of rejection interfere and we just "sit" on the stool.

Jesus calls us not only to come to Him, but to bring others to Him. Once we are His, we are commissioned to be His messengers, to tell others about Him.

The Apostle Paul said, "***God has given us the privilege of urging everyone to come into His favor and be reconciled to Him.***"

For many of us, this is not an easy calling. Many of us believe we need more study to acquire the right words, or to take courses to perfect our "how-to" techniques. We doubt our personal "ability," forgetting what God requires is our "availability." He is more than able and wants to use us to help Him do His work.

Encouraging church members to attend an Unidos en Cristo weekend can be an effective way to be a friend and bring a friend to Christ. At Clausuras, we often hear weekenders say they thought they were Christians before the weekend, yet it was the faithful persistence of the church friend who sponsored them that enabled them to enter into a personal relationship with Christ. So how do we get people to attend?

Q. What can we tell them about the weekend?

- A. Let them know they will hear relevant talks by pastors and other men [or women]. They will have opportunities to have really good discussions to help clarify faith questions. There will be a lot of special songs. They can expect to have fun in the process.
- Tell them you met people from a number of churches and made long-lasting friendships.
 - You might add a personal testimony as to the impact of the weekend. Testimonials are often more motivational than trying to convince them they should attend which might be perceived as saying they are a "lesser" Christian.
 - Avoid being too enthusiastic and building expectations too high. Hopefully, their unique weekend will be "the best weekend ever."

Q. What do you say if they've heard you sleep on the floor, have no showers, and eat "church" food?

- A. Advise them that a mattress is provided [a cot or bed, if needed due to health issues.] Let them know there is a shower and swim time, and that you found the food to be good.

Q. Any other suggestions?

- A. Pray that God will reveal who He'd like you to approach and to open their hearts in advance. Then, ask that person[s] if they've heard about or considered attending an Unidos en Cristo weekend because you personally found it to be quite worthwhile and recommend it. Offer to be their sponsor. This implies that you'll be involved and supporting them, that they aren't doing this alone.

It may help to let potential weekenders know how many from your church have attended. Name a few who might serve as references. Sponsors may help applicants complete weekend forms; submit them with your completed sponsor forms to your church's UEC liaison.

- Many 4th Day communities make a list of people they feel would be prime candidates and, to prevent "pressure" from an avalanche of invitations, a Cursillista who will approach them.

Take heart, we are only called to do our part. Pray first, extend an invitation, then let God do the rest.

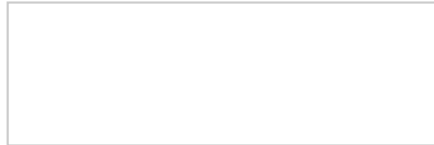
