## UEC's Testimonial DVD Is Good JOG!

June 24, during the Women's Clausura  
Faith Presbyterian Church

A short version of the long-promised testimonial DVD will be viewed during the Clausura. What you'll see and hear was designed to be the portion you might watch at a Ministry Fair, and it's the part you might go to if you think you don't want to bother with the whole thing. It will leave you wanting more.

The full DVD is 25 minutes long. A brief introduction explains the background and non-denominational nature of our Christian Community. Two other sections feature comments of 17 Cursillistas who talk about and share personal reactions to their weekends and subsequent team experiences, how their faith has grown, and how Cursillistas are serving in their home churches.

Release is planned for June. Information about its availability and distribution will be shared after the viewing so that you can plan how you might use it to encourage prospective weekenders to participate in UEC.

Individual reflections will have special interest to potential weekenders who are anxious to know more about a three day get away before committing to attend. Those who resist experiencing the gift of UEC because they believe that weekends are veiled in secrecy will learn that others who felt the same have understood in hindsight that more knowledge could have lessened the gift.

If you now attend a non-UEC church or if you want to share the three day experience with a friend who attends a non-UEC church, the DVD can help you introduce UEC to pastors. Viewers may choose which comments to hear first ~ those of the eight laity or those of the nine clergy.

Development of the DVD was considered for several years, and it supports two "priority tasks" recommended last spring by the Long Range Task Force. The quality and content of this new communication tool will help revitalize our image, and it will strengthen the UEC Community as we reach out to fellow Christians.

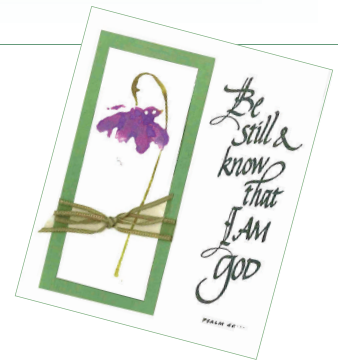

I write my final Convenor's Corner with humble appreciation for the privilege of serving on the UEC Council. It has been truly incredible to work with people of many denominations and churches, truly united in Christ and so dedicated to sustain and further this movement. They answered the call, "*Here I am, send me,*" so that our "short course in Christian living" would continue to renew the faith journeys of many.

Among the special rewards of serving on Council, besides working with such a good crew, is seeing all the behind-the-scenes efforts to keep this Christ-focused community moving ahead, listening to glowing reports of Rectors and Rectoras, plus meeting with teams during training and many of you at Clausuras.

The past five years have witnessed many changes and challenges. Newer faith programs like *40 Days of Purpose*, Alpha and other small groups could lead more people to this weekend experience. But Cursillista involvement and/or leadership in these activities (yea!) strains their continuing presence on team and as sponsors. Potential Weekenders are also torn by other commitments. This has impacted all "Cursillo" movements, resulting in weekends at less than maximum capacity and even weekend cancellations.

The Council has addressed this with special mailings to promote weekends, continuing efforts to train or give guidance to Church Liaisons, and sharing sponsorship approaches with the 4<sup>th</sup> Day Community. A new, more specific brochure, designed to help introduce people to UEC, was first offered at the 25th Anniversary Celebration. A DVD of testimonials by laity and clergy is being finalized to help generate interest in experiencing a weekend. [Information on the DVD is found on page 3.]

The Council always strives to make improvements and has made some excellent ones in leadership training by making manuals more user-friendly. The Palanca Press was redesigned, and the website is slated for a makeover. An investment in computer and projector equipment was made possible by a dedicated JOG; this sophisticated technology and a new portable sound system will add impact and amplification of Rollos and music in the Rollo Room. Policies are currently being reviewed and updated, and a myriad of items are "under construction."

Some changes reflect the dedicated research of the Long Range Task Force that spent almost a year surveying opinions, brainstorming a broad range of ideas, and assembling recommendations to help guide the Council in the coming years.

In closing, I urge you to "make a friend, be a friend, bring a friend to Christ." Christ is "still" counting on you. And, please always keep the Council and weekends in your prayers.

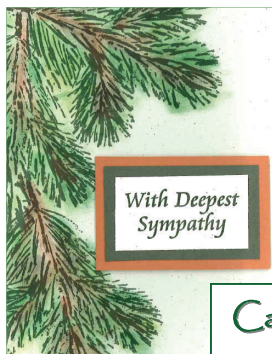
