It means that this information will be provided to the weekend team leaders. **REMEMBER - teams are formed 3-4 months prior to the weekend. If you have not been called for your requested weekend after submitting this form or have had to decline serving on a team when called; and, are still interested in serving on a future team, **please send a new completed team application form.***

How will UEC use the information you put on this form?

Your name, address, phone #, e-mail address and church name will be used to create a team roster which is distributed to all team members and weekenders on the weekend at which you serve. It will also be used to update your record in the UEC database. The emergency information will be used for emergency purposes at the team meetings or on the weekend only if needed.

Guidelines for Team Participation

By completing the form, you are committing to attend team meetings prior to the weekend. There are 3-4 evening meetings plus at least one overnight meeting. You are also committing to being present at the church throughout the entire UEC weekend.

UEC requires you to have attended an adult cursillo-type weekend before serving on a UEC team. UEC encourages team participation at any time after you have attended a UEC weekend. It is a good way to pass on the gift of grace you have been given and come to a better understanding of what happens "behind the scenes". It is also a very fun and rewarding experience. It may be wise to give yourself a little time to let your weekend "sink in" before serving on a team. To give everyone a chance to serve, we recommend serving no more than once per year and we encourage you to try all the teams as each team experience will give further insight into how to live a life of grace and extend that grace to others.

Pre-Requisites for Some Team Leadership Positions

Before serving as a Rector/a for a Support Team (Kitchen, Palanca or 4th Day), UEC **recommends** that you first serve on that team in another capacity at least once before.

In order to serve as an Assistant in the Rollo Room, UEC **requires** you to have already served as a member of a Support Team (Kitchen, Palanca or 4th Day), as a Rollista or Table Leader, and as Rector/a or Assistant Rector/a of a Support Team.

What is Unidos en Cristo (UEC)?

UEC is a structured three-day weekend designed to strengthen and renew the faith of Christian people bringing a new and more active awareness of living in God's grace. The weekend focus is on Christ and a personal relationship with Him. UEC begins on Thursday evening and ends on Sunday evening. There is an abundance of teaching, music, singing, fellowship, food, laughter, friendship and prayer throughout the weekend. *UEC is not sensitivity training, nor a treatment for personal problems or emotional difficulties.*
